### **IQAC Meeting held on 23/03/2016**

Members in attendance: Mr. Akok Walling (Principal & Chairperson, IQAC), Dr. M.L. Ngullie (Co-ordinator), Ms. Opangmenla, Ms. I. Suzzana Yaden, Mr. T. Zanthungo Ngullie, Mr. Neiketu Siam, Dr. Benjongkumba, Dr. Kashi Nath Singh, Mr. Ashok Kumar Jain.

Dr. M.L. Ngullie chaired the meeting and thanked all members for their presence. He requested them to introduce themselves to the Chairperson. He also read out the criterion-wise analysis report given by the NAAC Peer Team and said the certain observations need proper deliberation in the next meeting.

The Principal and Chairperson of the IQAC expressed his views that it is very encouraging for him to work under accredited college. He asked the members not to sleep but to work hard for the next five years to bring better results. In his speech, he said that the IQAC plays the vital role to build up the institution and is the nerve centre of the college.

The following agendas were discussed:

1. The members deliberated on exploring the possibility to create funds for the IQAC and Research Committee. The members felt that permission should be sought from the government to rent out the college auditorium for raising funds.
2. The members requested the Principal to enquire on the status of funds from the UGC, applied for by the Department of Education for conducting a National Seminar.
3. It was decided to collect Rs. 200 (two hundred only) annually from each teacher to support the research activities in the college.
4. The members of the IQAC expressed the view that there should be a common entrance test for admissions into both B.A. and B. Com programmes.
5. It was decided to notify all the Departments and Committees to submit their annual and five-year plan to the IQAC on or before the 30th of April 2016.
