The school has three departments i.e. Church, school and vocational and carry out various activities for boys and girls separately. Beautiful handicrafts made by the students were on display. Our students interacted with the students where the deaf students were very interactive and displayed their enthusiasm to learn. The visit to the deaf school had enlightened everyone about the special section of the people in the society and left a deep impression in everyone's heart.
