Activities and Events undertaken by Executive Members of Dimapur Government College Students' Council (DGSC) from December 2019

1. General Election of the Students Council and Executive Members of DGSC for the Tenure 2019-2020 was held on 25th of November 2019.
2. Installation programme for Newly Elected Students' Council Members of DGSC for the Tenure 2019-2020 was held on 29th of November 2019.
3. On 2nd of December The 1st Executive Meeting was held at the Council office.
4. On 7th of December, GS, along with one Representative to ANCSU attended the first Union Assembly of ANCSU - Tenure 2019-2020.
5. Annual college Sports Week was held from 11th - 13th of December 2019.
6. On 7th December 2019 The Students' Council organised a Mass social work within the college campus.
7. On 22nd January 2020 Students' abstained from attending class under the Directive given by ANCSU in solidarity support of total shutdown of all college and universities in Northeast States called by Northeastern University Students'.

8. On 25th of January, Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat (EBBSB) Club was formed under the direction given by MHRD. The club consists of 50 student members, headed by the club convenor Sir Khemendra Ritsa.
9. Students' Council along with Advisory Committee organised a class room cleaning activity where the BA 2nd Semester students were assigned for the work.
10. On 4th of February, a seminar was held for the BA and B.Com 6th Semester students in the College Auditorium on Motivational and Career guidance on the theme "Personal Development" which was organised by Career Counselling and Placement Cell DGC in collaboration with Kaziranga University Assam.
11. A competition on Poster Making, Best out of Waste, Speech Recitation and slogan writing was held on 24th January. The slogan and speech recitation was conducted by Literati Club DGC and the poster making and Best out of Waste was conducted by Performing and Fine Arts Club DGC.
12. Students' Council along with Advisory Committee organised a class room cleaning activity where the B.Com 2nd, 4th and 6th Semester students were assigned for work on 15th of February.
13. On 23rd of February, Introduction of 'Fit India Movement' was held in the Morning Assembly conducted by the Department of English.

Representing the voice of the students of DGC, The Duo placed an Agenda in the meeting to request the Nagaland University to reconsider the examination Routine gap on various subjects in the Under-Graduate Examination Routine, to which the house discussed and decided to make Request upon NU to reconsider the examination Routine by Next academic semester. Along with it many agendas like Kohima Science College Land Encroachment issue, scholarship issues, and many other agendas and issues raised by the student community were discussed.

15. On 27th of February, The first General Council Meeting was held in the college Canteen, Chaired by Vice President Mr. P. Sungjemtemsu. After the round of Introduction, Agendas were tabled and discussed. Under the directive of All Nagaland College Students' Union, to hold a candle light service for the cause of its demand with the State Government, concerning Government Colleges land encroachment issues, Scholarship issues, and various other issues raised by the union, The students' Council in solid and strong solidarity with the union organized a candle light service on 5th March, 2020, at 4:30pm in the college Auditorium. In the service Mr. Inagha Kinny - A.G.S. ANCSU as the representative of the union briefed the students about the set of issues raised.
20. The students' Council participated in a career counselling seminar on UPSC by Khan Study Group in collaboration with Department of Higher Education Nagaland on 5th March, 2020, at 10:30 AM in the college Auditorium.
21. Students' Council along with the advisory committee organized a classroom cleaning activity on 7th March, 2020, where B.A. 6th semester students were assigned for work.

22. The Students' Council participated in an "Awareness Programme on protection of women in India with special reference to Nagaland", organized by IBAC and internal committee for protection of women OGC, on 7th March, 2020, at 10:30 am in the college Auditorium.

23. On 9th March, 2020, the Students' Council participated in a Peace Rally on Naga Political Solution organized by Nagaland G.B Federation, in D.C Court junction, Dimapur.

24. On 13th March, 2020, the Lady Students' Council members participated in a programme organized by the college Authority for Girls Students and Lady Faculty, on the PAO vending Machine and its uses, which was addressed by the DROPOUT NGO, in the college Auditorium.

25. Seconding the interest of the Students Community, the Students' Council on 22nd March, 2020, wrote a letter to the ANCSU requesting them to appeal the Nagaland University on behalf of the students to postpone the exams, taking in consideration the widespread of COVID-19. The appeal was well taken and Accepted by the ANCSU. Further, on the appeal made by the ANCSU, the Nagaland University, dated: 23rd March, 2020, postponed the University exam until further Notice.

26. As per Directive of MHRD D.O. NO. SECY (HE) MHRD/2020, Dated 04th April 2020, to oversee students welfare and mental well being of students, the college constituted a Committee for COVID-19 on 06-04-2020, headed by Madam Kharienuo as the convenor, with seven faculty and three students Council members as the Committee members. The three Council members as an active Committee members assisted the teams in collecting all the Data and details of the needy students. Through the team More than 100 stranded Students was fortunate enough to receive relief materials of various Rations and Toiletries.

27. Students Council with 13th Student and in Coordination with the development Committee DGC conducted a social work to repair the side wall of the college in the roadside on 18th July 2020.

28. As the primary gap between the college office and the general students amidst the lockdown, the Students' Council actively assisted the Students and Students Assessment Committee in groundwork for connecting the Email ID and phone number of the Students for online class. This phase started on 15th July 2020, and continued for 10 days.

29. On the 4th August 2020, the 1st semester students was welcomed by the Students Council through online. Followed by a short orientation of the Students community. The Students Council also assisted the 1st semester Student in rectification of their email ID and contact numbers.

30. On 5th August 2020 two lady representative attended the menstrual hygiene awareness programme held at the DC's office in Dimapur. The programme was initiated by Dimapur Deputy Commissioner, Anoop Kinchi, IAS in collaboration with the Community Health Initiative (CHI). 36. On 19th August, 2020 the students Council participated in the Plantation drive at the college. Followed by it, a short programme was held where the Hon'ble MLA Shri. Moatashi Longkumer officially released the annual college Magazine 'Pursuit'.

37 On 4th November, 2020. the Students Council hosted the 2nd All Nagaland College Union assembly at the college Seminar Hall, where various issues pertaining to students community were deliberated.
