1. INTRODUCTION OF THE COLLEGE:

Dimapur Government College (DGC) was established in the year 1966. Initially as a Private Institution it became Government College in the year 1989. The College celebrated its Golden Jubilee on 3rd Nov. 2016.

Today the College offers two major streams namely, Arts and Commerce at the undergraduate level. Nine (09) subjects are offered in the Arts stream. It also has an additional wing of one Community College under University Grants Commission (UGC) Scheme which offers a vocational subjects leading to Diploma in Hospitality and Tourism Management. This training course is made available to Non-Collegiate members also in the Community. The Second vocational subjects offered at Dimapur Government College is the Certificate course in Floriculture introduced in 2016 under Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA).

The College has now a strength of 51 Teachers and 62 Ministerial Staff with 989 students.

Dimapur Government College was assessed by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in the year 2015 to fulfil the UGC requirement and was accredited as a 'B' Grade College at the National level.

Following the NAAC Accreditation in the year 2015, the College began the year 2016 with continued spirit of dedication and commitment for progress and development. And as the year closed, it has seen a record of some significant events, satisfactory physical development and encouraging performance taken place in the College beside other normal progressive works.
