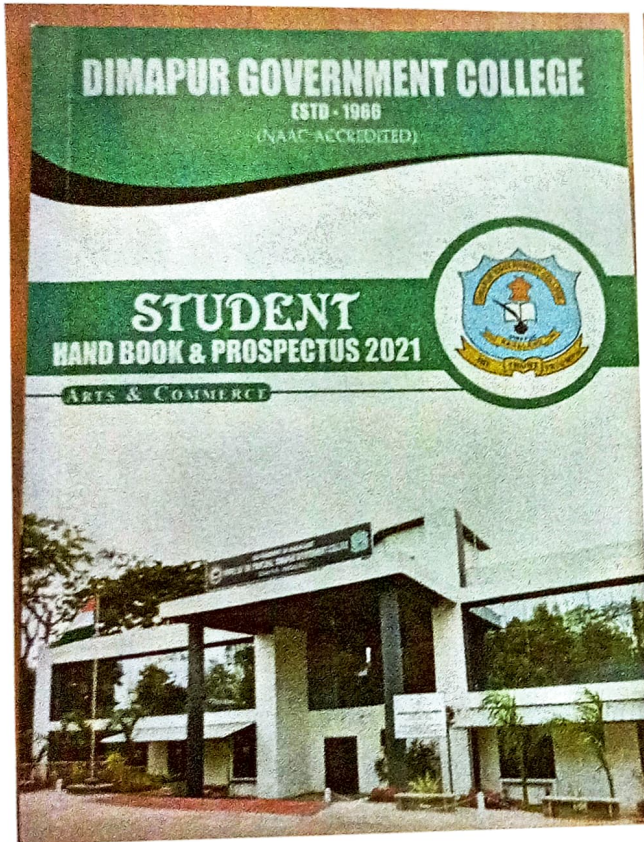


### Internal Committee for Protection of Women (ICPW) and Internal Complaint Committee

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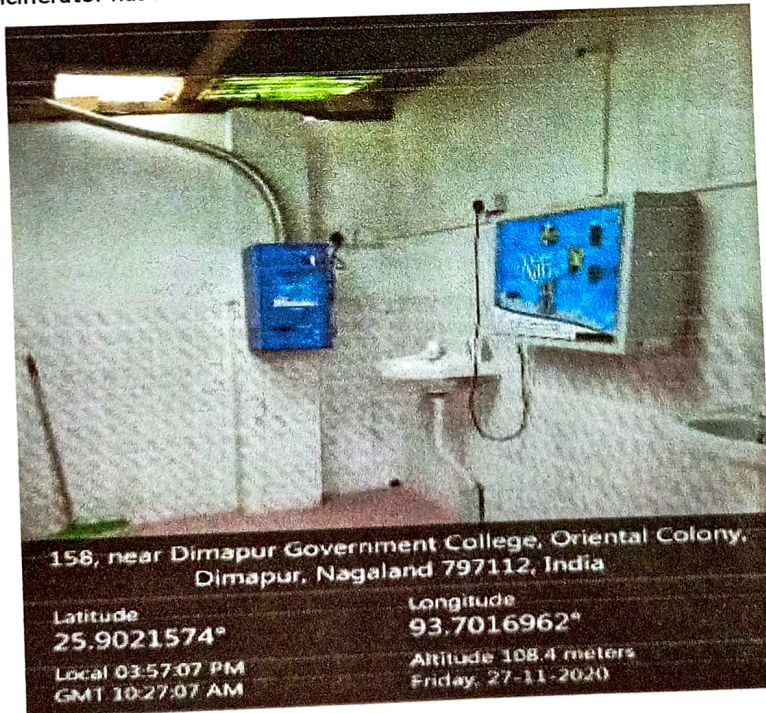

GUIDELINES FOR PRESIDING OFFICERS AND POLLING OFFICERS

1. Each officer in charge to take the Register (English/EVS) of their respective allotted class.
2. Check that all students have valid student Identity Cards/Library Cards. Defaulters should not be allowed to sit in the class.
3. Introduce the respective CR candidates and let all the candidates address the class for 3 minutes.
4. Explain the importance of correct voting and also about the inclusion of NOTA (none of the above) and voting to start according to Roll Nos.
5. The Presiding Officer is to take note that one male and one female is elected from each class.
6. After counting is done and results declared, enter the results and let the candidates sign first and then the Presiding Officer shall sign.
7. The elected Candidates should be personally escorted by the Officers to the Seminar Hall and be handed over to the Election Commission (None should be allowed to go out even for a short time).
8. Students should not be allowed to campaign in the class on the day of the election or move around in the class. They must be seated in their respective seats.
9. In case of a tie, the matter shall be decided by a draw of lot.

A sensitization programme on Menstrual Health and Hygiene was held on Thursday, 28<sup>th</sup> of April, 2022 at 12:30 pm in the college auditorium. The much needed programme was organised by the Internal Committee for Protection of Women and Internal Complaint Committee in collaboration with GlobalHunt Foundation. The purpose of the programme was to sensitize the girl students of the college on the importance of menstrual hygiene .

The committee convenor, Imtikokla Ozukum, Assistant Profesor, DGC welcomed all and gave a brief introductory note to the students.

Resource person, Nitya Chaudhary, CSR Executive, Unicharm India gave a comprehensive presentation on menstrual health and hygiene through online mode. She explained how the female body changes through adolescence and how to take care of it through the transition. Use and disposal of sanitary products in the proper way was illustrated. After the presentation, there was a question and answer session with the resource person.

Five faculty members and 46 students attended the program which was facilitated by GlobalHunt International as part of their CSR initiatives.

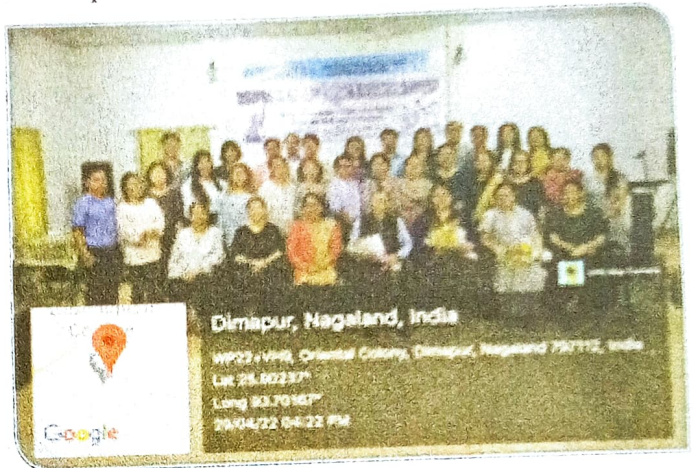
