* Due to the demands of the COVID-19 situation, an impromptu programme was held on **May 27, 2020** to inaugurate the newly constructed MI Room. Dr.Jamedi gave the opening remarks which was followed by a dedicatory prayer by Rev. Ariba Imchen , Associate Pastor of DABA .

Acting Principal Alemla Imsong cut the ribbon to officially inaugurate the MI Room. Thereafter, the key to the room was handed over to Supu Jamir, the Convenor for Covid-19 DGC Quarantine Centre who thanked the college authority for allowing the use of the facilities in the college to accommodate the returnees from other parts of the country.

The MI Room, a much-needed facility for the college had been constructed under the initiative of the Principal.



* As an extension service during the Covid-19 pandemic period, 3 (three) buildings of DGC (Boys Hostel, Science Block and Auditorium) provided to be used as quarantine centers from 1/6/2020 (two batches) and DGC has donated various preventive essentials (masks, hand sanitizers and surgical gloves) to Oriental Colony leaders to be distributed among vendors for their safety and security and thereby the safety of the consumers/public.



* The department of Political science, Dimapur Govt College, performed Community Extension Service through a beautification & plantation drive within Dimapur town on 6/6/2020.



* Workshop on “Designing E-courses on Effective Online Teaching” with Er. Shanchamo Yanthan, Asstt. Prof. Dept of IT, SET-NU as resource person was held on 03/07/2020 to prepare the faculty of the college for online classes.

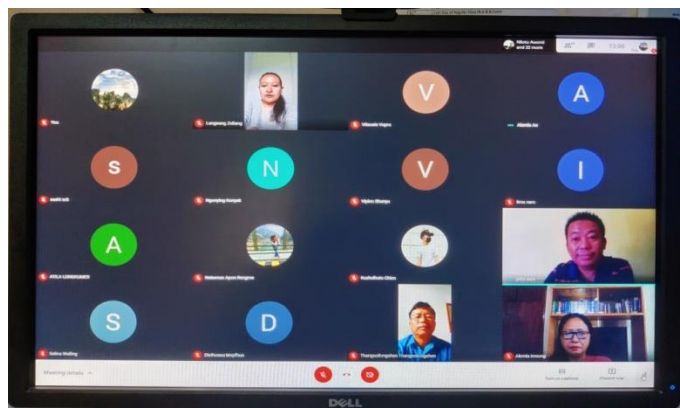

While interacting with her, she shared the experiences and challenges she faced while taking care of the aged people under her care.

At present there are 5(five) inmates from different communities including an Anglo-Indian. Besides the inmates, there are around 50 aged persons registered in this home who avail their services as and when required. The Home provides regular health checkups, counselling, short stays for senior citizens, prayer meetings, entertainment programs, library facilities, confidence building activities, and also outing programs.

The inmates also acknowledged the love, support and care they received from the Home. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, students were not involved so only the faculty members led by the HOD Lhipe Naro, Dr. Hannah Tia Assistant Professor, Herali Achumi Assistant Professor, and Sashirenla Assistant Professor went for the program. The department contributed some food items to the home.
