#### i. Performance in Diploma Course in Hospitality and Tourism Management:

This is a one year diploma course run by Community College under D.G.C. and is affiliated to N.U. It is a UGC initiative which facilitates vocational courses, along with conventional academic programmes. The last batch of students (August 2019-July 2020) have successfully completed the course. The current batch was delay due to Covid-19 Pandemic. 20 students (08M/12F) have enrolled for the current batch. All classes are currently conducted online due to the covid-19 issue



- 2. Five students from Dimapur Govt College representing Literati participated in the Annual Fest Renaissance Clique 'Ad Maiora' organized by the department of English,



# 14. Extension service and best practice :

#### **Extension Services carried out in 2020:**

• The department of Economics undertook a cleanliness drive at Oriental Colony, Dimapur as part of its extension service to the community.

• As part of community extension service, the department of Political Science of Dimapur Govt College conducted a beautification and plantation drive within the Dimapur city premises on 11 July 2020 from 5.00 am onwards. #### 1. Title - Students' Welfare Initiatives

- The College has 1316 undergraduate regular students. Each year the college received a good number of students who comes from economically weaker section. Thus, to give financial aid to the deserving students, the Students' Welfare Committee selects a few from amongst the poorest of the poor students especially those without parents, and extend a minimum financial assistance to them. The amount is fixed at Rs.400/- per month per student for 12 months subject to renewal after 1 year.
- For the meritorious students' different awards namely, Dr. Hokishe Sema award for topper in Arts stream from the college, L.T Yepthomi award for topper in Commerce stream from the college and other subject toppers like English, Economics, History, Political Science, Philosophy and Education were given out on 12/11/2020.
- Experts from various fields have visited the college for career guidance and counselling.

# Best Practice - 2 1. Title - Green Campus Project

 The college, through its green campus initiative, continued to identify the various environmental issues and take necessary steps to achieve the goal. Through its various cells like the Eco and beautification club, the Students Council, DGC RUSA Monitoring Cell (DRMC), the NCC and NSS, regular tree plantation is carried out. In addition, different species of medicinal and herbal plants are planted and identified in the college campus.

- To keep up its tag as one of the cleanest government colleges in the state of Nagaland, the college has conducted regular social work and cleanliness drives in and around the college campus where all the college community participate.
