IQAC meeting held on June 8, 2022.

Members in Attendance: Dr. M Libanthung Ngullie (Chairperson IQAC & Principal DGC), Dr Vinyühu Lhoungu (Coordinator IQAC), Dr. Hare Krushna Parhi, Dr. Yelhi Vero, Ms Herali Achumi, Ms. Lily Rino, Ms. Bokali Kibami, Mr Supong Jamir, Ms Kewe Vupru.

Meeting Agenda:

- 1. The Annual Action Plan of IQAC prepared by the IQAC Coordinator was approved by the House.
- 2. The Principal apprised the members regarding the fresh admission to BA/B.COM 1st Semester 2022 under CBCS Programme. He informed that the online registration for admission has been ended on 6th June and now the Scrutiny process is going on which is done by the Admission Committee. The selection of the candidate has been done on 2(two) categories of merit. Firstly the candidates with overall 45% and above were allowed to apply for the admission. Secondly each department is to give admission based on the subject specific merit list. The selection of the candidate is purely done on merit basis so that total transparency is maintained.
- In order to familiarize the freshers with the newly introduced Choice Based Credit System general orientation programme will be organized after the admission process is over.
- 4. The Principal also came up with the agenda that the Business Association of Nagaland (BAN) proposed to organize a panel discussion on "Oil Exploration and Extraction in Nagaland: The Way Forward" at Dimapur Government College. The members deliberated on the agenda and accepted the proposal. In this regard the Department of Economics in collaboration with the IQAC, DGC is entrusted to work out the modalities for the programme. The members also suggested that experts from the following organizations/departments will be invited: BAN, Geology & Mining Department, Nagaland Bar Association (NBA) and a member of Nagaland State Oil Committee. It was also decided that the programme will be organized before the commencement of the summer break.
- The principal also proposed to have a panel discussion on "Issues relating to Nagaland Liquor Total Prohibition (NLTP) Act 1989". The agenda is kept for the next meeting.
- 6. The Coordinator IQAC informed the members that Imperial IAS Academy wants to conduct a scholarship test for our students on 13th June 2022. The merit students will be given free coaching for UPSC and NPSC exams in their institution worth over Rs 1.3 lakh. The test is mainly conducted for the present BA/B.COM 3rd and 5th Semester

- students. However even the graduating students whoever is willing can sit for the test. The test will be conducted during last period i.e. 3pm-4pm.
- 7. The Coordinator IQAC also apprised the members that the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) submission for the year 2021-2022 is already due. Therefore he urged the members to seriously start working on it so that it can be submitted at the earliest.
- 8. The members also discussed that besides their academic studies students should be encouraged to take up online courses. In this regard the Principal's office from time to time may inform the students regarding the program schedule so as to help the students to avail the opportunity.
- 9. Shortage and difficulty in maintaining College Bus was also deliberated in the meeting. The Principal informed that besides the monthly collection from the students as bus fare which hardly suffices the fueling, the College do not receive any financial assistance from the Government for maintenance and repair. Moreover one bus which is 22 years old needs a major repairing for which the college is not in a position to bear the expenses. Therefore taking all these problems into consideration, the Students Advisory Committee is requested to kindly work out certain modalities for running the college bus for this semester.
- 10. The Principal also stated that he will correspond to the Higher Authority regarding the problem of the college bus so that the government may give it to private parties to operate for providing transport facilities to the students in future.
- 11. It was also mentioned that the Principal has started negotiating with leaders of oriental colony, Dimapur to permanently close the east gate so that no trespassing will be done by outsiders inside the college campus. The Principal will write an official letter to the oriental colony chairman for a meeting so that more deliberations will be made.



- 1. Orientation on newly introduced Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for students: To monitor and supervise the implementation of the CBCS, a CBCS Board was constituted vide Notification No. DC/ESTT-04/2010-11/ dated Dimapur the 16th May 2022. Meetings of CBCS Board were conducted on 20th May 2022 and 24th May 2022. Subsequently, an orientation programme on the introduction of "Choice Based Credit System" for the newly admitted students was conducted on 29th June, 2022 vide Notification No. DC/ ESTT-04/2010-11 dated 24th June 2022.
- 2. Proposal by Business Association of Nagaland (BAN) to organise panel discussion: Department of Economics and IQAC, DGC in collaboration with Business Association of Nagas (BAN) organised a Panel Discussion on the topic "Oil and Natural Gas Exploration and Production in Nagaland: Its Relevance Today" on 28th June 2022 in DGC Seminar Hall. Shri. V. Kashiho Sangtam, Hon'ble Minister for Soil & Water Conservation and Geology and Mining, Government of Nagaland delivered Keynote address. The panelists were Shri. Mhonlumo Kikon, Hon'ble MLA & Advisor, Information Technology and Communication, Science & Technology & New and Renewable Energy, Government of Nagaland, Shri. Kekhriezavi Lea, Team Leader, Operational Wing, Nagaland Petroleum and Natural Gas, Department of Geology and Mining, Government of Nagaland & OSD to the Government of Nagaland, Shri. C. T. Jamir, Senior Advocate, Guwahati High Court, Kohima Bench & President, High Court Bar Association, Kohima and Shri. Meyabi Arho Niphi, Deputy General Manager (Administration - Frontier Basin) Oil India Ltd. Duliajan Assam.
- 3. Proposal by Imperial IAS Academy to conduct scholarship test: Out of 321 registered students of all semesters in both Arts and Commerce Stream, 269 DGC students wrote the Scholarship Test on 13th June, 2022 in the college sponsored by Imperial IAS Coaching Academy, Dimapur. - 4. AQAR (2020-2021) submission: The AQAR for the period of 2020-2021 was successfully uploaded and the letter of approval was received from the NAAC office on 20th July 2022.
- 5. College bus shortage and maintenance: To work out modalities for maintaining college buses, the Bus Management committee was formed vide IQAC meeting agenda No. 1 dated 29th June 2022 and Notification NO: DC/ESTT-4/2020-11 dated 30th June 2022.
- 6. Permanent closure of east college gate: A meeting with the Oriental colony council members was held on 13th June 2022 at chairman's residence in connection with closing of the college east gate. The college



Preparation of AQAR was started by the NAAC Steering Committee members, presented before the IQAC on 9th December, 2022 in the seminar hall. Suggestions and feedback under different criteria given by the members were duly incorporated by the respective criterion in charges, successfully submitted on 19th December 2022, and re-submitted with additional supporting documents on 3rd January 2023.
- Shifting to new Library building: This agenda was re-discussed in the IQAC meeting held on 13th March 2023 (Agenda No.12)
- Upgradation of teachers' work room: Under the initiative of the Infrastructure Development Committee, separate Departmental cubicles were constructed. Also, personalised working tables were provided for each teacher from November 2022.
- 4. Members in attendance: Prof. Sanjay Sharma (Principal & Chairperson IQAC), Dr. Vinyuhu Lhoungu (Coordinator IQAC), Ms. Kezhaleu Hesso (Vice-Principal), Ms. Anungla Aier, Ms. Khrienuo Angami, Ms. Meripeni Ngully, Mr. Thangsoi, Mr. Lhipe Naro, Ms. A Sentiyula, Ms. Vipinou Kehie, Ms. Puli Chishi, Mr. Biswajit Sarkar, Ms. Diethoseu Mepfhuo, Dr. Jamedi Longkumer, Mr. Niketu Siam, Mr. Ashok Jain, Dr. Hare Krushna Parhi, Dr. Maongkala Longchar, Ms. Selina Walling, Dr. Asangba Tzudir, Ms. Herali Achumi, Ms. Lily Rino, Ms. Zuchobeni E Lotha, Capt. Hekiye Sema Retd. (External member), Mr. Sanjay Sethi (External member).

The Coordinator IQAC warmly welcomed the members to its first meeting after restructuring of the IQAC committee and introduced the external members Capt. Hekiye Sema (Retd), Mr. Sanjay Sethi and Mr. K. Temjen Jamir to the house. Prof. Sanjay Sharma, Principal and Chairperson IQAC gave the introductory note stressing the importance of the IQAC. He highlighted that every institution under NAAC has Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) who take important decisions and formulate policies for the development of the Institution. He thanked the members especially the external members for making themselves available for the meeting.

Agenda discussed

Award of Academic Excellence to students who top the university exam in each honours subject:

A proposal was brought by the HODs before the IQAC that in order to encourage students to excel in their university exams an Academic Excellence Award will be instituted in the college. The award will carry a cash prize of Rs. 25000/- and a citation. The members deliberated and agreed to accept the proposal. The award will be funded by the college. The members also discussed at length the marking system of the college, placement of students after graduation etc. the members suggested that the college should come up with proper mechanisms to improve the marking system so as to enable the students to score well, at the same time the quality of education should not be compromised and also stressed on the importance of mentoring students to create an impact on them.

2. Funding of Minor Research programme - department wise

It was decided in the meeting that in order to develop an interest in research amongst the faculty members each department is asked to submit a research proposal latest by 30th September 2022. Funding will be done by th ecollege. Fund will be given basing on the nature and volume of the project.

3. Re-affirmation of introduction of PG courses

The department of Economics, Philosophy and Education have submitted a proposal for the introduction of PG courses. However there has been no positive response from the

Government. Therefore the three departments are entrusted to set a committee including members from the respective departments, Principal and the Vice Principal to pursue the matter.

4. Re-affirmation of introduction of Science stream

The Principal apprised the members that the government is ready to introduce all the seven science departments in the college. However as the present science block building has insufficient classrooms and laboratory rooms it will not be feasible to introduce all the discipline in one go therefore the Principal suggested that only three subjects ie Physics, Mathematics and Computer Science be introduced initially as these departments supplement each other and also resources can be shared within these departments. The members deliberated on the issue and decided that the college will apprise the Government regarding the issue and ask the Government to introduce the subjects in phased manner.

Resource centre - for skill development initiative.

Coordinator IQAC apprised the house that under NEP 2020, skill based program should be included in the curriculum where the students can earn while they learn also NAAC insists on the sustainable source of income of the college. For this purpose the college need to have a resource centre. The members deliberated on the issue and made a proposal that a committee comprising of few members will be set up who will identify the area for skill development and frame the modalities for opening of resource centre in the college.

6. CSR funding to support quality enhancement initiative.

Coordinator IQAC highlighted the importance of donations and helped received from the external agencies as one of the components to fetch good grade during NAAC Assessment and requested the members to explore more funding agencies. It was suggested that the college can make project proposals and submit to potential funding agencies.

7. Closure of college east gate:

Coordinator IQAC highlighted the members that public thoroughfare in the middle of the institution is one of the hindrances for securing good grade during NAAC assessment. A negotiation between the oriental colony council members and the college was in progress which was initiated by the former principal Dr. Libanthung M Ngullie.

The Coordinator, IQAC, apprised the house regarding the new downsized IQAC composition and initiated the meeting with a review of the previous resolutions of IQAC meeting held on 9th September 2022, 10:00 AM at Seminar Hall, DGC. In this context, the following Action Taken Report (ATR) was presented to the House:

Action Taken Report (ATR) of Previous IQAC Meeting Resolutions:

- Award of Academic Excellence: A general notification has been issued in this regard, vide Notification NO: DC/ESTT-4/2020-11 Dated 12th September 2022, to award Rs. 25,000/- and a Citation to students who top the University Examination in each Honours subject.
- Funding of Minor Research Project: Departments were asked to submit the Research
 proposal for funding. Majority of the Departments have submitted the proposal which is
 under review. The Principal has informed the house that fund for the same shall be
 released by the next Academic Session, July 2023.
- 3. Re-affirmation of introduction of PG courses: Proposal for PG courses in Education, English and Economics was submitted to the Directorate of Higher Education. The Directorate has recommended for PG course in Education and has submitted to the Government for approval. Furthermore, the Principal informed the house that application in this regard is ready to be submitted to Nagaland University for approval.

- Re-affirmation of introduction of Science Stream: The Principal has informed the house that Post-creation for the introduction of Science Stream is still an issue with the Government.
- 5. Introduction of Integrated Teachers Education Program (ITEP): On the direction of the Higher Education Department, the College had applied for ITEP through online mode and successfully uploaded the required documents in the NCTE Portal on 26.5.22. But due to failure in providing Fire Safety Certificates on the stipulated time, the proposal was rejected for Academic Session 2023-24. However, the Principal informed the house that the College is now ready with all the necessary documents including the Fire Safety Certificates to re-apply when the ITEP portal is re-opened for the next session 2024-25.
- 6. Resource Center for Skill Development initiative: Dr. Maongkala Longchar Coordinator, Skill Development Committee, informed the house that several Skill Development trainings have been initiated in the College. In this regard, Dr. Longchar informed the House that the following Skill Trainings has been conducted till date:
 - i. Skill training on Employability Skill Sets and Career Guidance under Youth Employment Programme by Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) was conducted for BA & B.Com 6th Semester students from 24th January to 10th February 2023 with Ms. Lamneithem Vaiphei, Trainer, TCS, as Resource Person; and Coordinated by Dr. Maongkala Longchar, Asst. Professor, Department of English.
 - ii. UNNATI Soft Skill Training sponsored by HE Department, Govt. of Nagaland for BA & B.Com 6th Semester students from 6th February to 23rd March, 2023 with UNNATI Change Makers Ms. Mhabeni Ezung and Ms. Lamniu S. Shiu as Resource persons from UNNATI, Bangalore; and Coordinated by Ms. T. Asenla Longkumer, Asst. Professor, Department of History.
 - iii. 1st Batch of Workshop on Financial Markets from 13th to 16th February 2023 sponsored by Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) for B.Com 6th Semester students with Mr. Chenio Lotha, Resource Person on Financial Education, SEBI, as Resource Person; and Coordinated by Dr. Vinyühu Lhoungu. 48 students have successfully completed the Workshop.

- 7. CSR Funding: Rain Water Harvesting & Ground Water Recharging and construction of high quality toilets have been identified for CSR funding. The College has approached Dept. of Geology & Mining to prepare a DPR for Rain Water Harvesting & Ground Water Recharging Project. However, Geology & Mining Dept. has expressed their inability to prepare the DPR. The College Jal Shakti Team is entrusted to contact other technical person for the same.
- 8. Closure of College East Gate: The Principal along with Dr. Vinyühu Lhoungu, IQAC Coordinator, Ms. Meripeni Ngullie, HoD History Department and Mr. E. Lichumthung Kikon, Coordinator, IGNOU Centre, DGC met the Oriental Colony Chairman at the latter's residence on 22nd September, 2022 and reiterated the necessity for closure of the gate. The meeting ended with positive note from the Chairman and suggestion for the College was made by the Chairman to meet a few individuals who are still adamant not to close the East Gate.

Resolutions on Meeting Agendas:

The Coordinator, IQAC, initiated the discussion on the meeting agendas and after thorough deliberations, the following resolutions were made:

Further, the House approved to allot a room adjacent to the Principal 30 Cogistic facilities: Proposal for the following logistic facilities was approved by the Coordinator's Table and Curtains in IQAC room

- 4. Financial assistance: Proposal for the following financial assistance was approved by the house and it shall be consolidated under funding for Departmental Minor Research Project, as mentioned in the Action Taken Report (Sl. No. 2):

 - ii. Exam remunerations to teachers for dissertation work.
 - iii. Project works to be taken up by the Departments.

Action Taken Report (ATR) of IQAC meeting held on 13th March 2023

- 1. Admission matters: Admission into the college in UG courses from the upcoming new Academic session to be conducted through entrance test under the nomenclature Dimapur Government College Entrance Test (DGCET) was advertised in the college website and all major local dailies such as Nagaland Post (Pg. 10), Tir Yim Yim (Pg.7), Capi (Pg. 4), The Morung Express (Pg. 7) on 23rd and 24th of May, 2023.
- 2. ICT Budget Proposal: An amount of Rs. 4 (Four) Lakhs were sanctioned to the ICT Committee for further enhancement of ICT facilities in the college. The committee purchased and upgraded the following:
 - 1. Three (3) projectors installed in Classroom No. 22 (Arts), Room No. 2 (Economics) and Room No. 3 (Commerce)
 - 2. One (1) CPU
 - 3. Two (2) microphone stands
 - 4. One (1) printer for Commerce Department
 - 5. Five (5) projector pointers

Further purchases and upgrades are underway. Also, the room adjacent to the entrance (Left side) of Seminar Hall was allotted to the ICT Committee for safekeeping of ICT gadgets vide Notification No.DC/ESTT-4/2020-11 dated 29th March 2023.

- 3. Logistic Facilities: In a phase wise manner, the following logistic facilities were purchased: IQAC Coordinator's table, curtains in IQAC room, separate washroom for ladies, mini cabinet with wash basin in the IQAC room.
- 4. Magazines and Journals for college library: Notification No. DC/ESTT-4/2020-11 dated 29th March 2023.
- 5. Assessment of Learners: The Learners Assessment Committee conducted a meeting on 1st April 2023 regarding the agenda to formulate Institutional policies for students' learning capacities. The following resolutions were made:
 - 1. Examination & Assessment Policy to be formulated by the Vice Principal.
 - 2. Teachers to return answer Scripts and Assignments with feedback to students. Notification to be issued by the Vice Principal in this regard.
- PridoVice Principal's Office to issue notification to all Departments regarding Re-Tests/ 3. Vice Principal's Office to provide Mark list of all Department students for every Internal

Improvement Tests.

- Tutorials for toppers and Remedial classes for backlog students and slow learners to be continued by every Department.
- Students Assessment Committee (SAC) to keep written records of Internal and External Examination related meetings and correspondence.
- 7. All Departments to maintain a format to track students' academic progression in a register. In this regard, toppers and weakest students are to be identified after every Internal Assessment and University Examinations.
- Mentoring Policy to be formulated and mentoring classes to be featured in Class Time Table
 on first Saturday of every month. Furthermore, Mentoring Committee to start working
 immediately and allot mentees to newly joined teachers.
- Psychology Department has been assigned the task to formulate a Methodology to map the outcome of learners.

Consequently, the Department of Psychology was assigned the task vide Notification No. DC/ESTT-4/2020-11 dated 11th April 2023.

- Professional Development Programs/ Trainings and Faculty Exchange Program: Teachers
 were encouraged to attend the programs and training.

- Rain Water Harvesting Projects and Toilets for Boys and Girls: DPRs have been prepared by and submitted on 25th March, 2023.
