In continuation of the ongoing DGC Mentorship Programme and with due permission from the College Authority and IQAC, the DGC Mentoring Committee organized an introductory mentoring session with the newly admitted students of 2022. 597 students were divided among the 45 faculty of DGC and met for an hour-long session. The students were 485 freshers from Arts and 91 freshers from Commerce. Additionally, there were 20 Arts 3rd Semester students and 1 Commerce 3rd Semester student who had been transferred mid-session from other colleges. Each teacher-mentor were assigned 10-13 student-mentees with every effort made to assign students to their Honours-subject faculty so that the students may be provided guidance and supervision by their own department teachers in their academic progression as well. The session consisted of collection of details of the students in the prescribed proforma, orientation of the students on the concept and goals of the mentorship programme of the College and also a general familiarization with one another of all parties involved in the exercise. The College provided refreshments to the faculty after the session.
