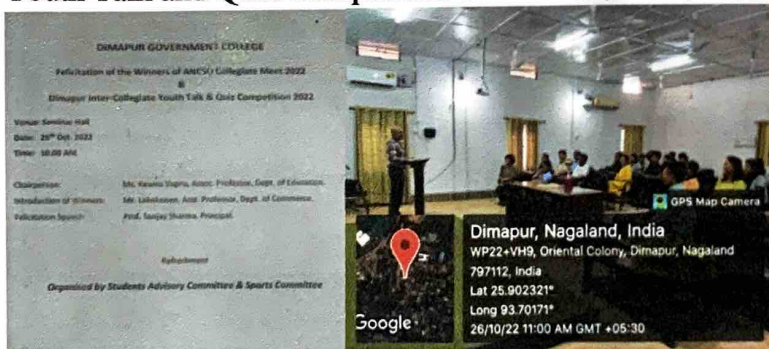

### Annual Report (2022-23)



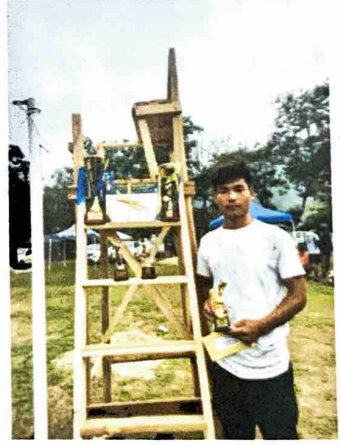


