4.1.1. Institutional Feedback on the Syllabus and its transaction

The student's satisfaction survey was conducted for the academic year 2022-23 based on the questionnaire provided by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). The survey was conducted in the month of May 2023 for the even semester students.

A total of 1400 students from Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) and Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com) participated in the survey, comprising of 476 male and 924 female (Male- 34% and Female 66%). Responses are analyzed and reported in percentages with pie-charts.

It was observed from the survey that irrespective of gender the responses of the students were positive and they reported to be generally satisfied with the various parameters of the teaching and learning process of the college.

The students in their feedback opined the need to improve the infrastructure of the college which needs to be taken note of and changes brought accordingly for the better functioning of the college.

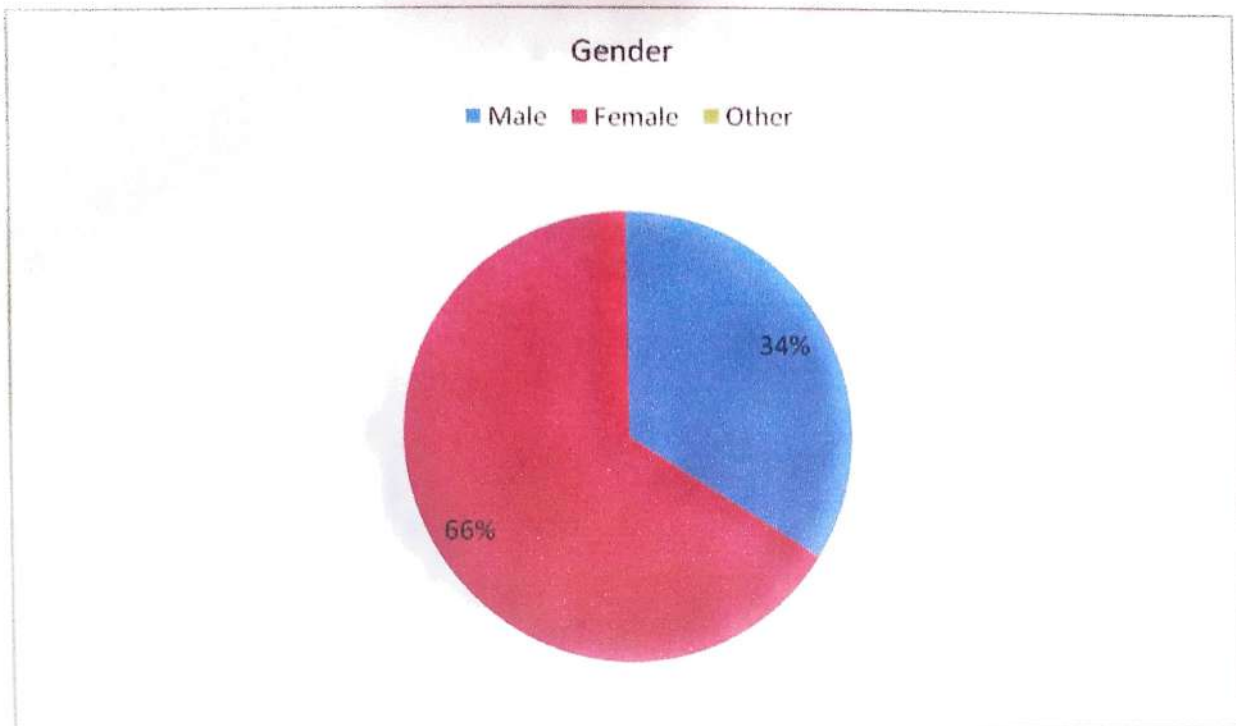

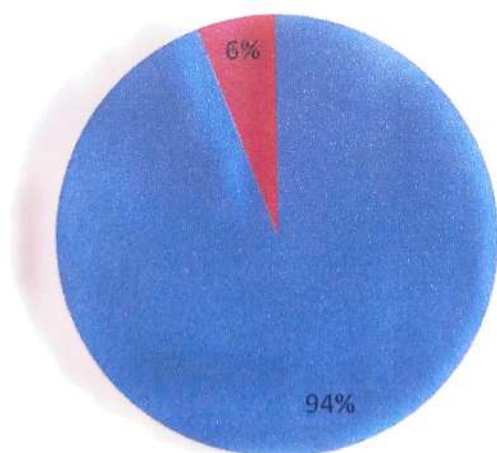

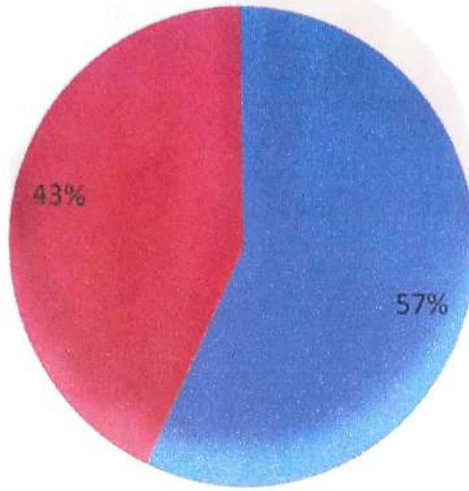

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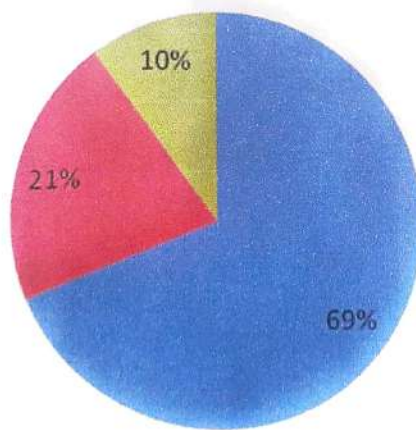

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

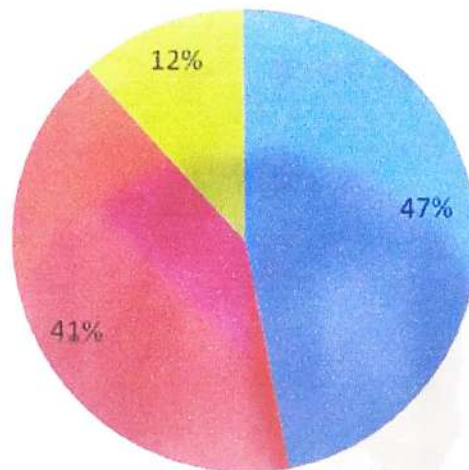

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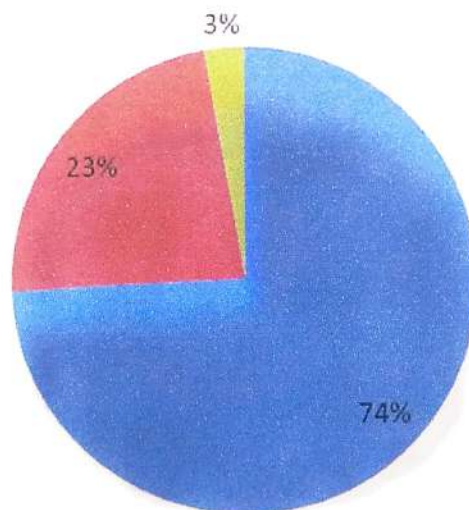
4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

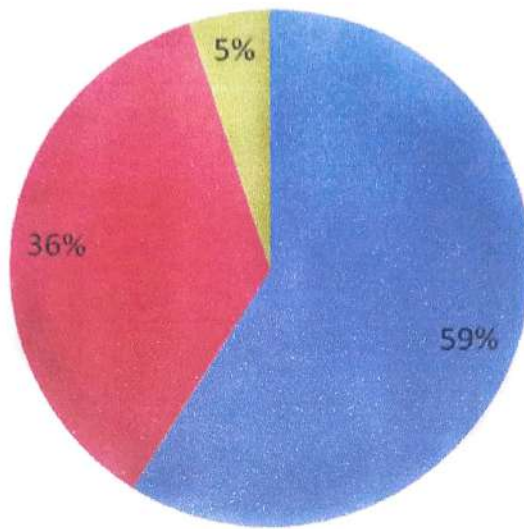

Teachers Satisfaction Survey 2023-2024

Dimapur Govt. College conducted a survey of the teachers as per Criteria 1.4.1 of the AQAR to collect information relating to their satisfaction towards the curriculum, teaching, learning and evaluation system implemented in the college. This survey is conducted annually to ensure that the vision of the college is accomplished with the proactive involvement of the teachers.

The survey for the academic year 2023-2024 was conducted on 29th April 2024 based on the questionnaire provided by The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). A total of 47 teachers participated in the survey. Upon analyzing the responses it is understood that the teachers are satisfied and have given positive response to most of the parameters of the teaching learning processes followed in the college.

However, the need for attention on few areas was brought to the fore. The survey has highlighted the need to introduce more skill-based courses, review of the syllabus, course balance between theory and application and insufficient books in the library. A major area of concern and the most dissatisfaction is underscored in the need to improve Infrastructural facilities such as teacher's rooms, classrooms, reading rooms and toilets

Some of the suggestions given by the teachers are the need to streamline co-curricular activities as the college seems to be prioritizing extra-curricular activities over the fundamental aspect of education. Extracurricular activities need to be reviewed to ensure they compliment rather than detract from academic priorities. Systematic monitoring system is needed to address the concerning trend of low students attendance. Teaching and non teaching staff require training program on work ethics and professionalism for a healthy work environment.

Hence, going forward focus should be on these areas of concern that have been highlighted and ensure those are done away with for the efficient functioning of the college.

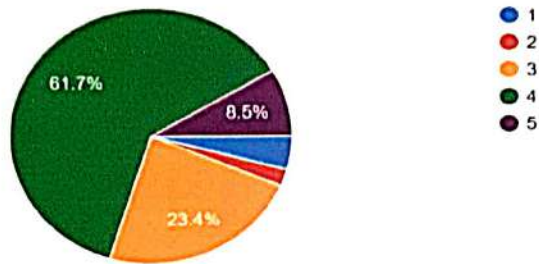
