

#### DIMAPUR GOVERNMENT COLLEGE STUDENTS SATISFACTORY SURVEY REPORT 2023-2024


The Students satisfaction survey based on the questionnaire provided by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) for the academic year 2023-2024 was conducted in the month of April 2024. A total of 1560 (female-65% and male-35%) major students participated in the survey. The students belonged to eight different departments that offered major courses. The department-wise survey follows as Commerce (17.69%), Economics (10.38%), Education (14.48%), English (10.44%), History (14.16%), Philosophy (7.50%), Political science (15.19%), and Sociology (10.13%). Out of total respondents, 82.31% of the participants were from the Arts stream and 17.69% were from the Commerce stream. Detailed report of the data are analyzed and presented in the form of pie-charts.

As per the survey, it was observed that students were positive and greatly satisfied with the teaching and learning process while a certain percentage of students were dissatisfied with three parameters from the survey:









1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




#### 2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?




