1. Harbinger Fest:

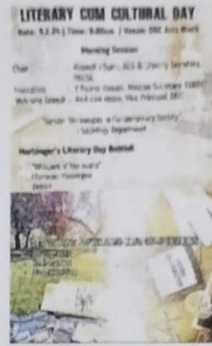


3. Cultural Attire
