



Sl no	Suggestions	Action Taken
1.	Development of proper bathrooms and maintenance	A modern type restroom is under construction.
2.	Administration staff lacking efficiency while disbursing admit Card.	Suggested to Principal for deputing a teacher to man the smooth functioning.
3.	Science stream must start	Proposals sent to State Government on several occasions.
4.	Expand Library	Proposals sent to concerned authority to shift to new Library building
5.	More goal- oriented and skill training for the students	Under Skill- Hub initiative college has already started imparting skill training in various trades.
6.	Give more importance to financially unstable students	Students are selected for admission through entrance test, which is mandatory. For the financially weak and deserving students there is Students Welfare Fund Scholarship sponsored by the faculty. The DGC Alumni Association also started a Scholarship scheme for financially weak students which was launched in October 2023 and awarded to selected students.
7.	Improve teaching facilities, extra-curricular activities.	ICT provision installed in some classrooms where the teachers are using for class. Besides the different Clubs in the college, every Department has a departmental club and all these clubs are packed with extra -curricular activities.
8.	To introduce digital library, Infrastructure	The collection of the library has been enhanced with purchase of books amounting to Rs 910000/- in 2 allocations during the period and E-resource facilities have been supplemented by providing some eBooks on e- book software calibre.

Annual Consolidated Report (JUNE 2023 - MAY 2024)

1. As part of the requirements for setting up Entrepreneurship Development Center (EDC) & Incubation Centre (IC) in the college under Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship (IIE) Guwahati, funded by NEC, the names and type of business were collected in July 2023. Altogether 20 successful and well-placed alumni entrepreneurs were enlisted.
2. The Alumni Committee conducted a survey to capture the opinions of the alumni under five important heads. A questionnaire was administered to all the alumni through the Google Docs.
3. In a first of its kind in the history of DGC, the alumni association decided to start a scholarship to help the financially poor students to be sponsored by few conscientious alumni.
