CLUB ACTIVITY REPORT

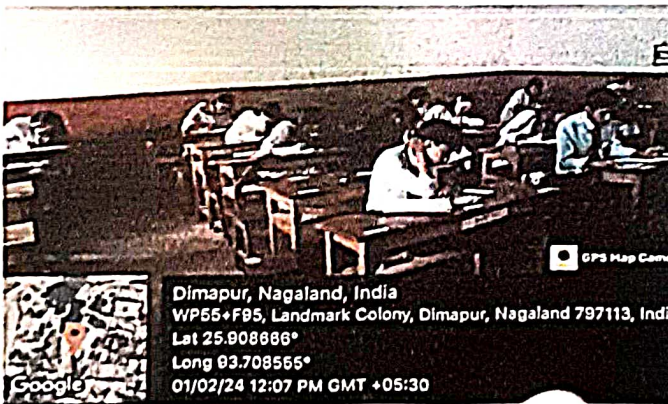
