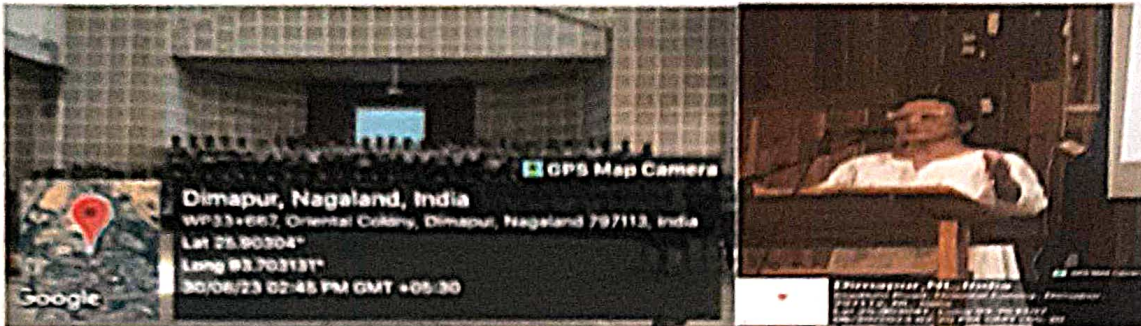
Report from June 2023 – May 2024




3. Report on the **Inter – College Debate Competition** organised by the Department of Political Science in collaboration with the Debate and Quiz Club of St. John College:

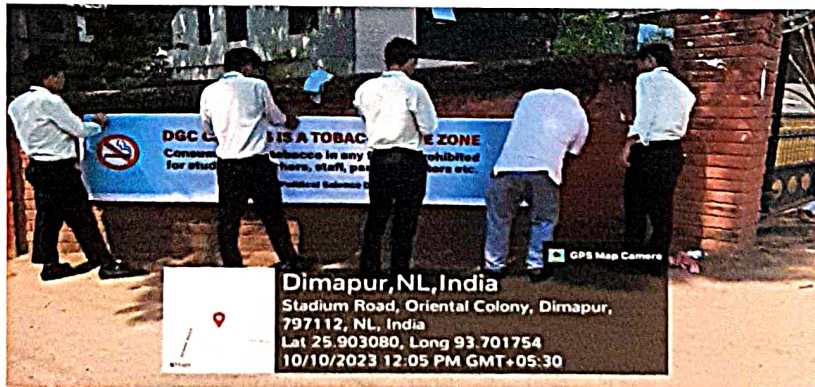
Mr Pauleuhing Teilia, an honours student of Political Science Department, DGC was the winner. He represented the opposing team.


5. **‘No Tobacco Zone’** Adopted and maintained by Political Science Department in the College Campus.

8. On 27th March 2024, a ‘Mini Parliament’ was organised by the Political Science Club in collaboration with the Political Science Department of the College.

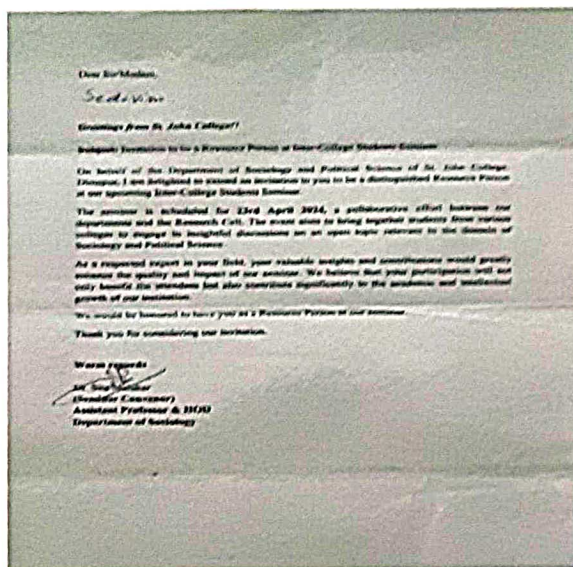

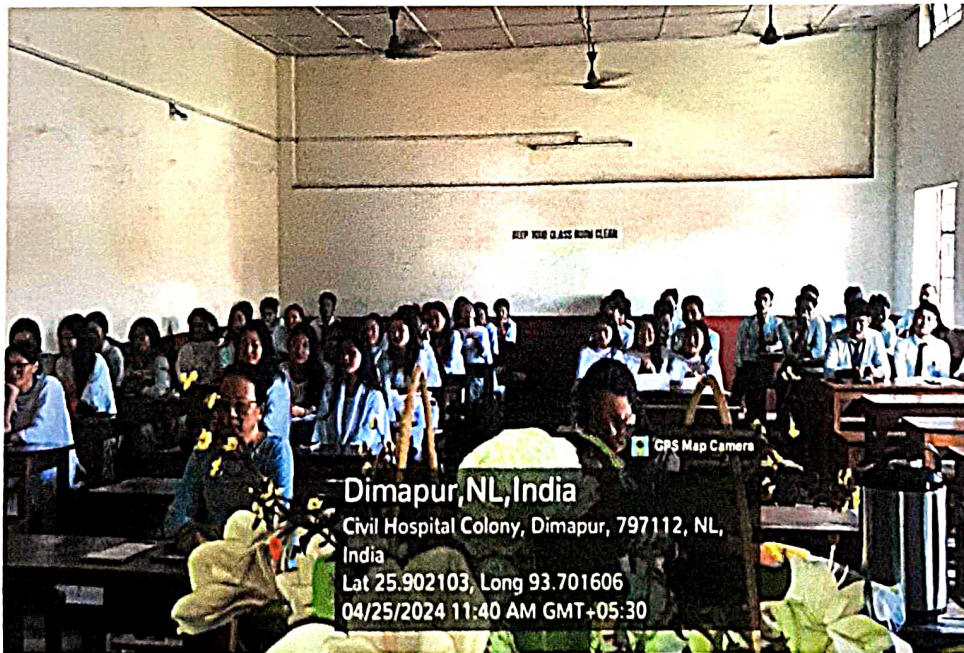
