51 students and 5 lectures attended the programme.

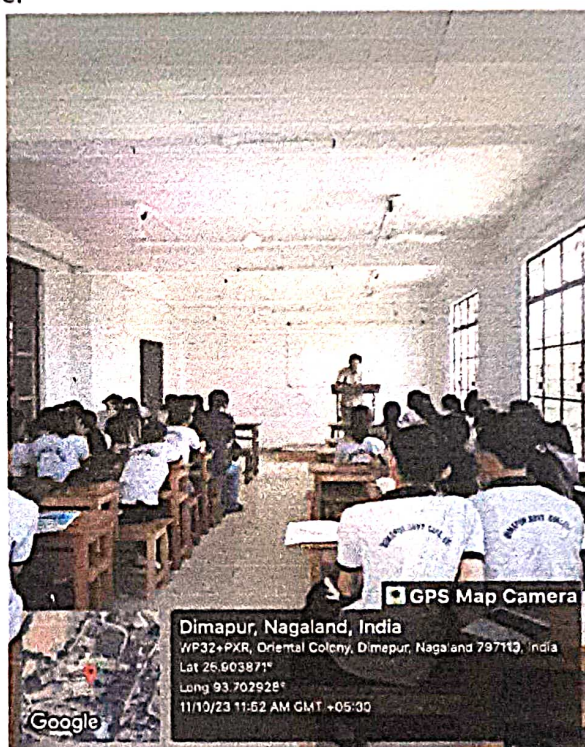

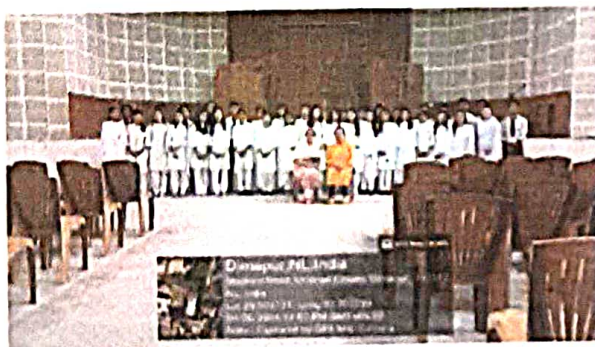
8. Economics club, DGC donated 5 dustbin for both degradable and non-degradable waste to commerce block on 10/4/24.




9. Dr Vinhuu Lhoungu, Asstant Professor: IQAC Coordinatiour, went as External examiner to Yemhi college on 26/4/24.
