REPORT ON 2ND MOCK PARLIAMENT:


The Political Science Students' Club in collaboration with the Department of Political Science organised 2nd Mock Parliament as one of the student activities featured in the road-map of the Department under the banner "*Where voices meet, decisions shape and nations define*", on 1st April 2025 at 10 AM in the Auditorium. In attendance 05 teaching faculty and 197 student participated in the program.

The Vice President Nivilo K Zhimomi of 5th Semester as the host delivered a welcome address, she stressed on the following points; 1. Giving chance to actively participate in democracy to experience civics management. 2. To help students develop analytical and argumentation skills. 3. To Enhance confidence in speaking. 4. To provide opportunity to lead and organize. 5. To Promote team-work, and negotiation skills. 6. To help students Learn about democratic processes. 7. To stay informed about relevant issues.

The agenda were: 1. Budget 2025-2026. 2. One Nation One Election and New Education Policy 2020. There were 34 parliamentarians with the Bharata Janata Party as the ruling party and the Congress as the opposition. The Parliament Session began with the National Anthem. The house started its business with oath taking ceremony conducted by the Speaker followed by Presidential address and presentation of the budget 2025- 2026, agenda on One Nation One Election and NEP 2020 for deliberation and debate for and against by the ruling and opposition parties. During the Zero-hour, important issues on persistent water scarcity, Aayushman Card, Manipur Meitei- Kuki conflicts calling attention of National importance was brought before the house for deliberation and adopted significant resolution on the agenda.
