

The programme was attended by 51 students and 5 Lecturers.

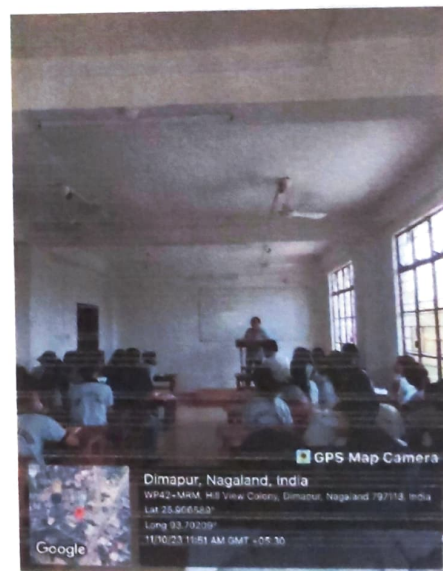
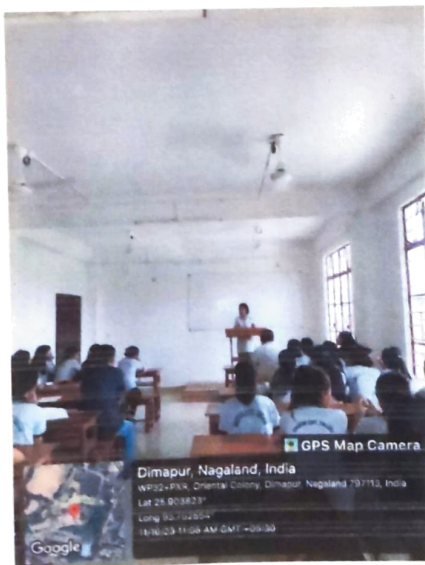

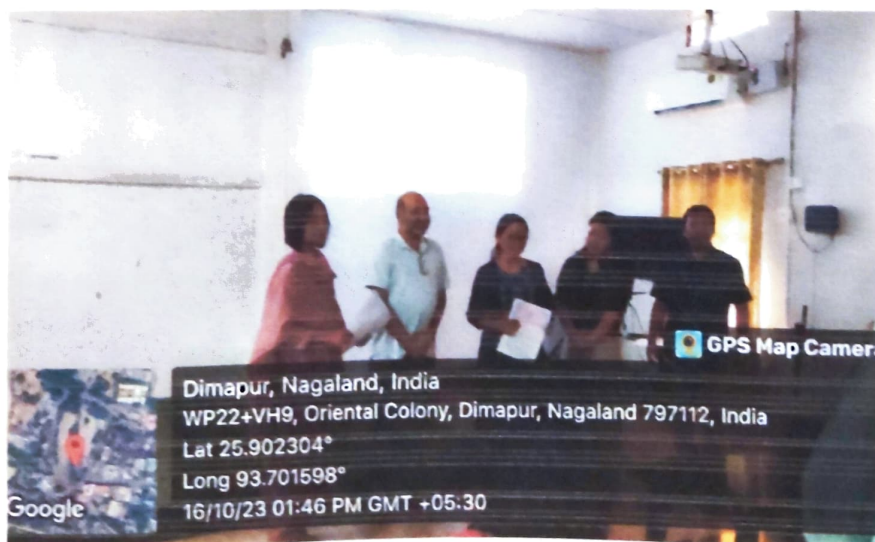

The department of Economics in collaboration with North East Network (NEN) observed *World Food Day* under the theme, *"Water is life, water is food. Leave no one behind"* on 16<sup>th</sup> of October, 2023 at the Seminar Hall, DGC Campus from 1pm onwards.

The chairperson was Dr. Yelhi Vero, Asst. Professor, department of Economics, DGC and the speakers were Prof. Sanjay Sharma, Principal of Dimapur Government College and Wekoweu Tsuha, State Coordinator, NEN Nagaland.

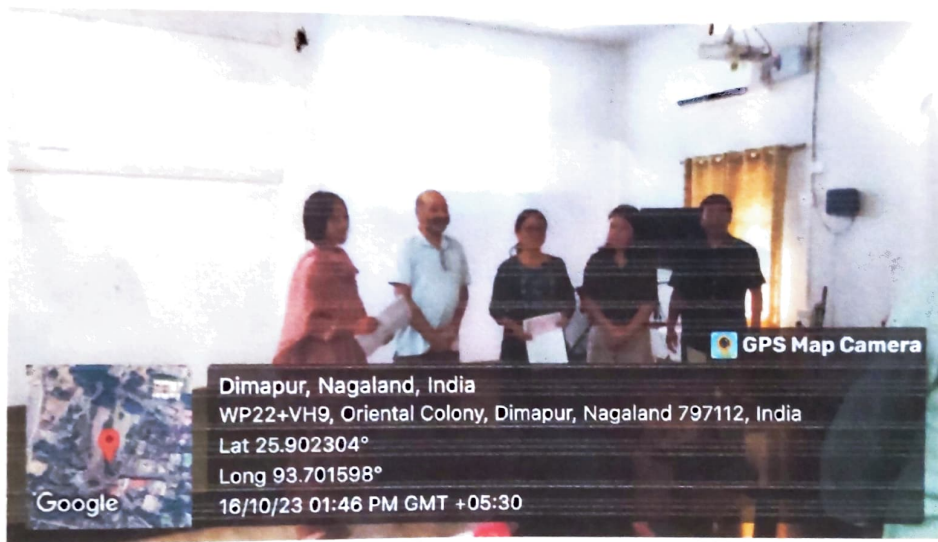


