Report of the 3rd Dimapur Govt. College Alumni Association Scholarship Award

The Dimapur Government College Alumni Association (DGCAA) Scholarship has entered its third year of implementation. As in previous years, an official notice was issued inviting eligible students to apply. Applicants must meet specific criteria in order to be considered for the scholarship.


A total of fourteen applications were received for the scholarship. Following individual interview sessions with each applicant, seven students were shortlisted for the award.

The Scholarship Award Programme, organized by the Dimapur Government College Alumni Association (DGCAA) in collaboration with DGC Alumni Connect Cell was held on 16th October 2025 at 1:30 p.m. in the college seminar hall. The event was chaired by Mrs. Purtila, Treasurer of the Alumni Connect Cell, Dimapur Government College (ACCDGC).

The programme commenced with an address by the Principal of Dimapur Government College, who urged the students to strive for academic excellence and to utilize the scholarship for its intended purpose. He emphasized that the selected recipients were privileged to have been chosen from among many applicants.

Following the Principal's address, the scholarship beneficiaries were invited to briefly introduce themselves, with each student allotted two minutes to speak. This segment was succeeded by a speech from the President of DGCAA, who encouraged the students to remain diligent in their pursuits. He noted that while the monetary value of the scholarship may be modest, it's symbolic significance and the intent behind it were of far greater importance.
